Board Meeting Minutes

Attendees

Proceedings

Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM by President, Mike Kiel.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes were approved, by the group, as presented.

Approval of 2023 Tournaments

The board approved the 2023 tournaments as presented by each clubs.

Email from Casey

The meeting started with a brief discussion about the email that Casey sent to MSCA. The group started with the state shoot survey and Mike brought up other things mentioned in the email as the meeting went long.

Recap Shoot Survey

MSCA members voiced their comments and concerns about the state shoot survey. Casey stated that the survey should provide information about who is going to have access to it and how MSCA will use it before asking members to fill it out. Some members commented that the survey should be available for all MSCA members to review, not just to MSCA Board and hosting club. The Board received the comments and concerns from the members who attended the meeting, Mike stated that the purpose of the survey is for the hosting club to take feedback from the shooters who participated in the shoot, the club can decide to release it to general public or use it however they want. We think it's the best to continue to do this in this manner.

Recap state shoot meeting

In Casey's email, some members mentioned that they didn't hear the announcement for the MSCA Annual meeting at the state shoot. Mike apologized for the miscommunication and stated that we will bring out a white board to put the meeting information on it and make this information more apparent for members to see.

A few issues brought up during the annual meeting:

A member stated that he has been receiving emails from MSCA. Mike collected this member's email and gave it to Pei, Pei has put his email on the contact list.

A few members didn't receive the pins from the 2021 state shoot. Mike has been working with Blue Creek and the members to get the pins mailed to the members. Pei was able to get a mailing address from one member, while the other two members hasn't responded yet. Mike asked Pei to email the address to Blue Creek for them to mail out the pin.

Some members suggested MSCA should put some money back to class for in-state shooters. Mike would like to receive some comments about how to do this, then come up with a plan.

Back to some items from Casey's email that weren't previously discussed:

Casey reiterated that it is not her intention to ask the MSCA to share the result with the general public, she just would like MSCA to provide the information about who is going to see the result on the survey, so members have this information before filling out the survey.

New Business

There was no new business brought up.

Time for general public

Casey stated it is each club's job to make sure participants receive their rewards after the shoot, it is more important to focus on other things such as updating the website, sending out financial reports to members and such.

Mike Lupold asked a question that according to the by-laws, is it required to provide rewards for top three in-state shooter per class? Moose provided the information from the by-laws: "The Main Event in-state prizes shall be awarded to three places in regular classes and one place for concurrent categories. There shall be means by which non-residents are eligible for additional prizes to three places in regular classes and one place in concurrent categories." This didn't happen at 2022 State shoot, members suggested that MSCA should enforce this starting 2023. In addition, youth shooters should be reimbursed, Greg said he would look into this and do the calculation, then MSCA will send out checks to eligible youth shooters.

The next meeting date is scheduled for Jan 10th at 6:30 PM.
